




## INSTRUCTIONS FOR CONSENT




3 – On the 'Related Entities' (1) tab find the 'Actions' button;





1 – In <https://registo.dns.pt> log in with the NIC-Handle and password set;




2 – Select the domain where you want to remove the consent to the public disclosure of personal data in WHOIS;

4 – On the 'Actions'(2) button select in which quality you want to remove consent. For example, for the holder, select 'Change Owner Confidentiality'(3);



5 – Read and analyze the message carefully because from this moment your personal data will no longer be available in the WHOIS system;



6 – Confirm acceptance by clicking on 'Confirm'.
