Data Verification and Validation



Why do I need to verify and validate my data?

Within the scope of the Cybersecurity Legal Regime (RJC), which transposes the requirements of the European NIS2 directive into Portuguese law, critical entities such as .PT have to ensure that data associated with .pt domains:

- Exist;
- Are correct and up-to-date;
- Effectively belong to the respective holders;
- Has operational contacts.

What's the difference?

Validation

Confirms that the data is:

- Correct;
- Complete;
- Coherent.



Verification

Confirm that the contacts are:

- Real;
- Active;
- Operational.



What data should be validated and verified?

Data	Validation	Verification
Name	✓	—

When is it mandatory?

- New registration;
- Transfer of ownership (for the new holder);
- Change of contacts.

Validation period

Verification and validation are valid for **3 years**.

Revalidation is only required after expiration and when performing an operation that requires data verification and/or validation.

↳ Who handles verification and validation?

The verification and validation of data can be carried out in different ways, depending on the situation.

↳ If your domains are managed by a Registrar

Verification and validation must be made by your registrar when:

- Your contact already has registered domains under the management of that Registrar;
- Your contact will be created by the Registrar.

➤ If you don't have domains under the management of a Registrar

You must access your Reserved Area in the .PT system and verify your data before:

- Registering a new domain;
- Accepting ownership of a domain.



➤ If you manage third-party domains, but you are not a Registrar

Before registering a new domain or initiating a transfer of ownership, you must ensure that:

- The data of your nic-handle is verified in your Reserved Area;
- The nic-handle data of the new owner's domain is also verified in the respective Reserved Area.

If the data has already been previously verified and validated, and the 3-year validation period is still active, you can proceed directly with the domain registration or transfer of ownership.



If the data of the managing entity itself is not verified, the domain registration and transfer of ownership operations will be blocked until the respective verification is complete.

How to verify my data in the Reserved Area

1. Go to www.pt.pt; >
2. Click on “Reserved Area”; >
3. Log in using the predefined **credentials** (username/password)





8. In the window that appears, click on "Request confirmation code";







9. In the "Confirmation Code" field, enter the code you received in your email or phone. Then click "Save";

To set a secondary contact as main, the contact must be previously verified.

When creating a new entity and/or user, the email is automatically verified, and it is only necessary to verify the phone contact.

Request for Data Validation to .PT

In some situations, it may be necessary to request .PT to validate your data directly through the Reserved Area.

This happens, for example, when:

- There is already a contact created in the .PT system;
- This contact does not have domains under the management of a Registrar;
- You want to use that contact later to register a domain or accept a transfer of ownership through a Registrar.

For privacy and data protection reasons, Registrars are not able to view the data currently associated with an existing contact in the .PT system that is not under their management.

In these cases, it may be necessary to update the data directly in the Reserved Area and later request the respective validation from .PT.

Before requesting validation from .PT:

- Main contacts must be verified;
- The entity's data must be correct and up-to-date.

.PT may request documentation to confirm the information submitted.



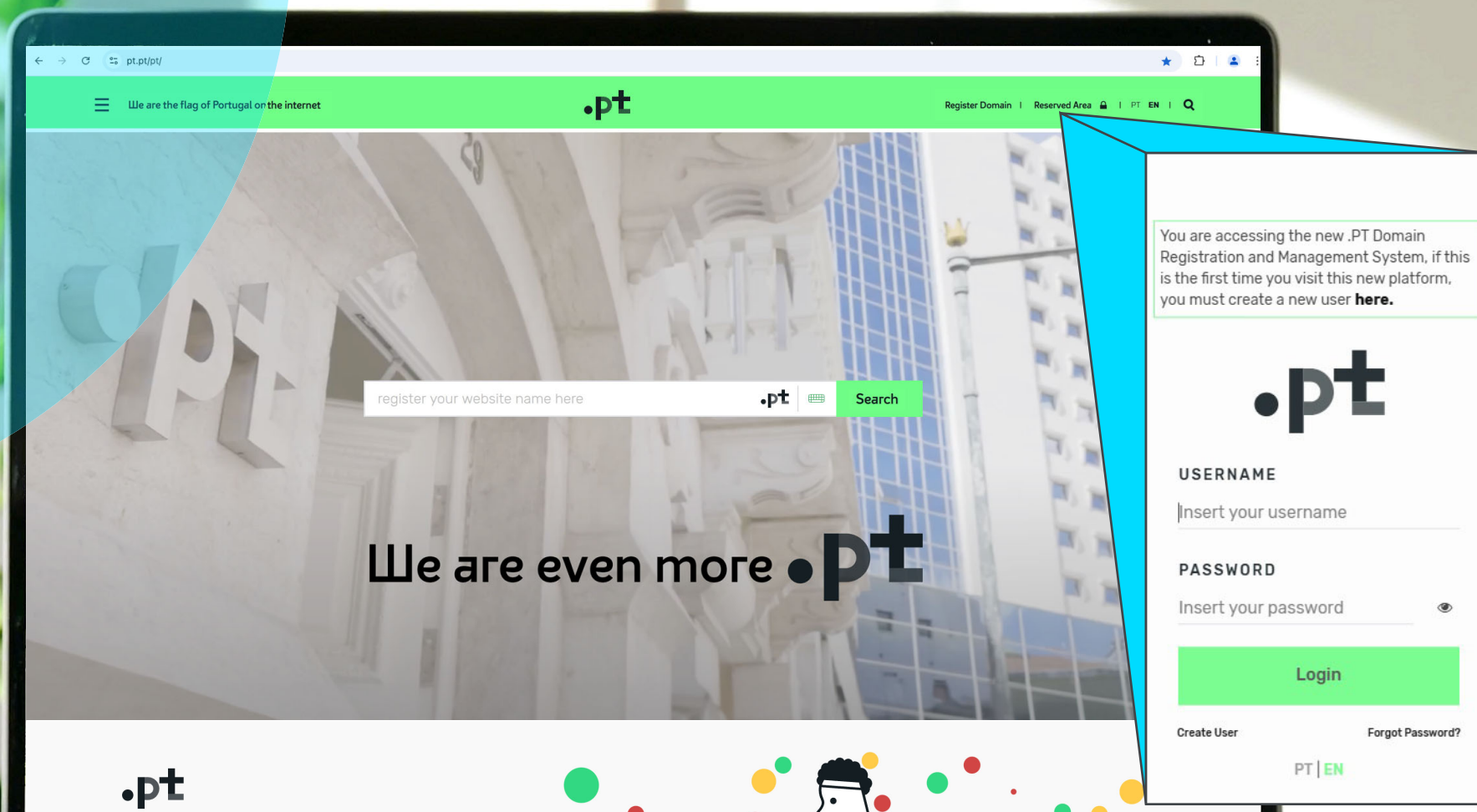
The "Data Validation Request" action will only be available to entities that do not have domains under the management of a Registrar.

If you already have domains associated with a Registrar, verification and validation must be carried out through the respective Registrar.

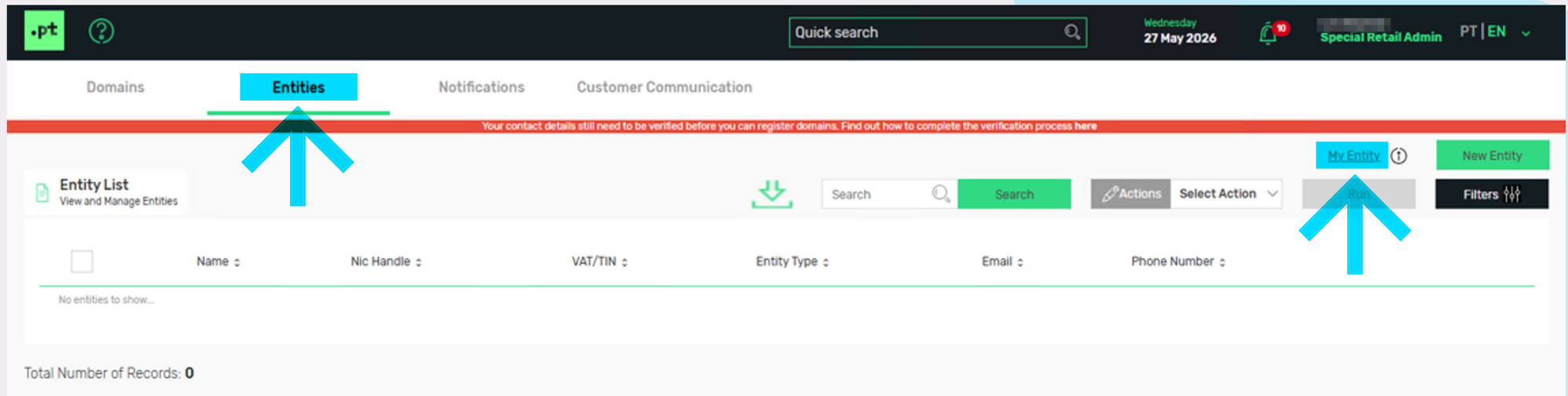


How to request data validation from .PT

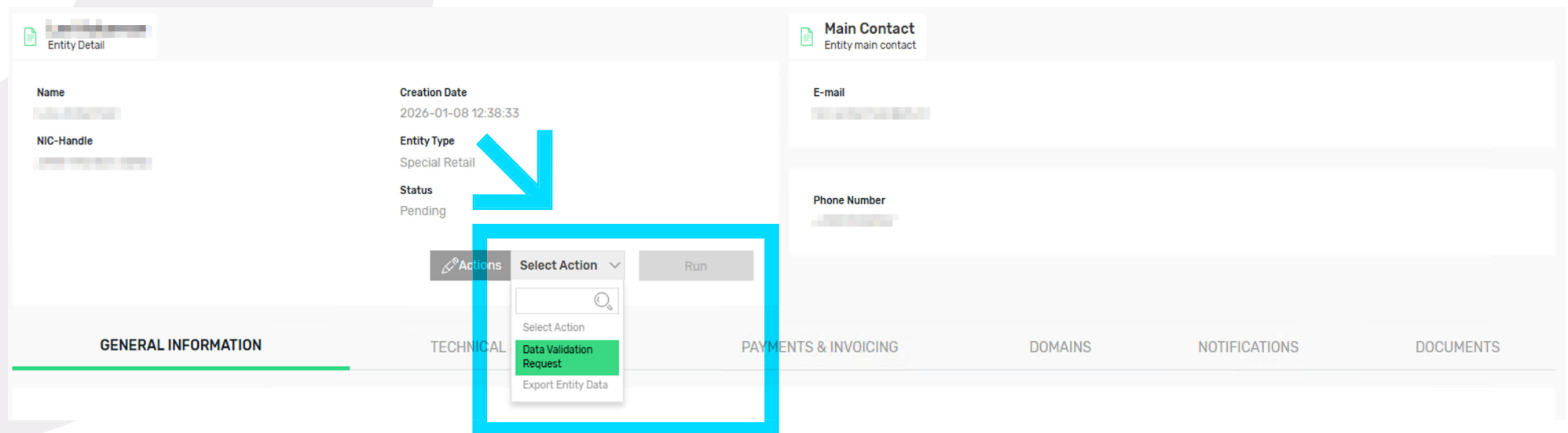
1. Go to www.pt.pt; >
2. Click on "Reserved Area"; >
3. Log in using the predefined **credentials** (username/password)



4. Go to the "Entities" tab and click on "My Entity";



5. On the entity page, select the "Data Validation Request" action and click "Run";



6. You will see the confirmation of the request made;

7. After submitting the request, .PT will analyze and validate the information submitted. If there are doubts or inconsistencies, additional documentation may be requested or the data presented may have to be corrected.
